It is the PARENT/GUARDIAN'S responsibility to notify Lambton Public Health of **ALL** immunizations a student/child receives at the doctor's office or hospital. Doctors do not forward this information.

It is the law in Ontario for Public Health to maintain current vaccination records or exemption documents for every student attending school. According to this law, students with incomplete vaccination records can be suspended from school.

*All pupils entering nursery, elementary and secondary schools must be immunized against DIPHTHERIA, TETANUS, POLIO, PERTUSSIS (WHOOPING COUGH), MEASLES, MUMPS AND RUBELLA, MENINGOCOCCAL DISEASE, and - for children born in 2010 or later - CHICKENPOX according to the IMMUNIZATION OF SCHOOL PUPILS ACT 1990 and the CHILD CARE AND EARLY YEARS ACT 2014. Exemptions are for conscience or religious beliefs (must have a signed affidavit) or medical reasons certified by a physician.
